

# CONSTITUTION OF THE SHILLONG CRICKET ASSOCIATION

## 1. Name and Jurisdiction of the Shillong Cricket Association :

- (i) The Association shall be called the "Shillong Cricket Association" hereinafter called the S.C.A.
- (ii) The S.C.A. shall have its headquarter at Shillong. However, there may be another temporary office of the S.C.A. at the place where the Hony General Secretary resides.

## 2. Area of Operation :

The jurisdiction of the S.C.A. shall intend over the entire District of East Khasi Hills and to such adjoining areas who desire affiliation with the S.C.A. But such adjoining areas falling under the territorial jurisdiction of another District, will automatically cease its affiliation with the S.C.A. if such District forms its own District Association.

## 3. Object of the Association :

The aims and objects of the S.C.A. are :

- (i) To encourage, promote, foster, upgrade, develop, control and spread the game of Cricket in the District and its adjoining areas.
- (ii) To admit bonafide Cricket Club as specified in the existing guideline of the Association as member of the S.C.A. and to conduct regular Cricket Tournament for both Senior as well as School Tournament and age group competition.

**Definition** : Cricket Club means properly constituted Cricket Club having memorandum and Rules and regulations and having proceeding books, Cash books, etc. with membership register.

- (iii) To encourage formation of Cricket Club / Association to control the game of Cricket in areas where there is no such Club for the purpose.
- (iv) To instill a sense of cooperation and conduction among the affiliated clubs and to arbitrate in matters of dispute concerning the game of cricket.
- (v) To invest the funds of S.C.A. in such manner or manners as shall be deemed to be in the interest of the game and the S.C.A.
- (vi) To pay special attention and care to the development of Cricket in Schools and colleges in the District and to give all possible help to the affiliate Clubs.
- (vii) To form Umpires Board for maintaining a Panel of Umpire of different categories and to do such acts as may be necessary for the purpose.
- (viii) To make, any, alter, maintain and enforce Rules and Regulations for the control and governance of Cricket in the District and to maintain discipline amongst players, officials and affiliated bodies.



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- (ix) To purchase and acquire any movable or immovable property or any interest therein which shall be considered beneficial to the Association or necessary for the development of the organization and to own and control ground, pavilions and stadia.
- (x) To do all such lawful acts as are incidental or conducive to the attainment of the above objects.
- (xi) To accept, take over or acquire any Trophy that it may deem proper for the development of Cricket.
- (xii) To erect and maintain a Fund for the purpose of its activities raised through subscription, donations or by holding charity matches.
- (xiii) To develop true opportunity and spirit in the game and to foster the spirit of discipline through the game and to protect the rights and privileges which the members are entitles.

4. **Membership** :

- (i) membership of the S.C.A. shall be open to all bonafide Cricket Clubs, Institutions, University, Association and Company within its jurisdiction. Application for membership shall be made to the Association for consideration on or before the 31<sup>st</sup> October of every year. Such applicants when granted affiliation shall be called Affiliated member and shall pay an Annual fee as specified herein after.
- (ii) An affiliated members shall pay an affiliation fee of Rs. 300/- per annum to the Hony Treasurer S.C.A.
- (iii) Applications for new membership to be renewed by G.M. and new members is to be admitted only after the same have been approved by the Governing Body.

5. **New Membership** :

In granting new affiliation, the following principles shall be adhered to the satisfaction of the S.C.A.

- (i) The new member must possess a contribution of their own which must be sent to the S.C.A. along with the list of office bearers, Registration member if any, and full report of the activities of Club.

6. **Life Member** :

Any person having interest and involved either directly or indirectly may apply for life membership on payment of Rs. 10,000/- at a time. Such application will be considered by the General Body of S.C.A. after the same is placed for consideration before the Governing Body by the Hony. General Secretary. The G.B. if satisfied may recommend the same to the Annual General Meeting for approval.



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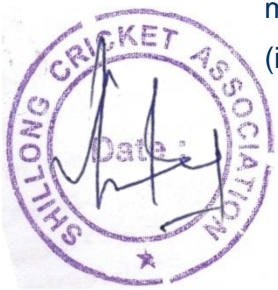
7. **Obligation of Affiliation Units :**

- (i) An affiliation Clubs and Association shall abide by the rules and bye laws of the S.C.A.
- (ii) Every affiliation Clubs and Associations shall be responsible for the conduct of its officials, players and members and supporters both in and out side the ground of play and shall take all precaution necessary to prevent spectators threatening or assaulting Umpires or players or Officers during or at the conclusion of matches.
- (iii) Every Clubs shall satisfy itself about eligibility of a player before registering his name with the Association / Clubs who include unsizertured or ineligible players in this team shall be guilty of indiscipline and Governing Body shall have the power to take step accordingly.
- (iv) Casual vacancies among the Member of the Association shall be filled by the Club whose representative has caused the vacancy electing or nominating another responsible person in his place.
- (v) No affiliated units shall take part in any Tournament in or outside Shillong without previous permission of the Governing Body. No player of an affiliate Clubs or Association shall take part in a Charity / Exhibition / Benefit match or a Tournament which is not recognized by the Association without prior permission the G.B.
- (vi) In Charity or exhibition matches organized by the Association, all affiliated Clubs must release their players selected for the Match. Any Club failing to comply with the provision of this rule, without sufficient grounds, to the satisfaction of the Governing Body, shall be debarred.
- (vii) Clubs who win Trophies shall furnish a receipt in the form obtainable from the Hony General Secretary and shall be responsible for any loss or damage during the period the trophies are retained by them.

8. **General Body :**

The Supreme Authority of the S.C.A. Shall Vest on the General Body which shall consist of 2 (two) representatives from all affiliated Clubs / Associations and the elected members of the existing Governing Body and all life Members of the S.C.A. (Members representing any affiliated Clubs / Units must be a member on the units and concerned Association will certify to that effect in the credential). For such meeting 21 clear days' notice be given by the Secretary to all members of the Association mentioning the business to be discussed.

- (i) To elect the G.B. including the office bearers, Chief Patron and Patrons.



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- (ii) Adoption of the Audited Account presented by the Hony. Treasurer.
- (iii) Adoption of the Secretary's Report.
- (iv) Review of the work of the out going council.
- (v) Consideration and acceptance of the amendments to the construction, if any.
- (vi) Consideration of any other business of which due notice has been circulated under the Rules.
- (vii) Consideration of any appeal from the members which has been referred to the meeting by the Governing Body.
- (viii) Election of an Auditor (Chartered Accountants).
- (ix) To form different committees and Sub-committees, Tournament Committee, Selection Sub-Committee, Umpire Board Sub-Committee, Coaching Sub-Committee.

**Note** – To be eligible to be a member of the selection Sub-Committee, one must at least have played for the SCA in the past. Members of such committee need not be necessarily member of General Body.

- (x) In the General Meeting whose election is not due only Items (ii), (iii), (v), (vi), (vii) will be considered.
- (xi) In the event of Voting, procedures as mentioned in clause 15 shall apply.

9. **Quorum** :-

In all meeting of the General Assembly, one third of the numbers of members shall form the Quorum but in a requisition meeting two third of the members shall form the same. No quorum shall be required in a meeting adjourned for want of quorum. The Annual General Meeting adjourned for want of quorum shall be held within some days, generally at the same Venue and hour of the original meeting.

10. **Special General Meeting** :-

A Special Meeting of the Association may be convened by the Secretary in consultation with the President whenever he may think necessary and also upon a requisition signed by at least half the members of the Governing Body study the business to be submitted at such meeting. No less than 7 clear days notice of such business shall be given by the Secretary to members of the Association and no other business shall be discussed at such meeting.

If the Secretary failed to call a Special meeting within a reasonable time on a requisition by half the members of the Governing Body as mentioned above, the



requisitions shall approach the President or in his absence the Senior Vice-President and with his permission directly call a meeting of the General Assembly.

11. **Governing Body** :-

The S.C.A. shall be administered and managed by a Governing Body Consisting of the following to be elected by the General Body in the A.G.M. They are :-

- (i) The President
- (ii) Four Vice-President
- (iii) One Hony. General Secretary (One Asst. Secretary)
- (iv) Three Hony Joint Secretary.
- (v) One Hony. Treasurer.
- (vi) One Secretary Umpire Board.
- (vii) And eleven other Governing Body Members to be elected in the Annual General Body Meeting from persons representing the affiliation clubs and Associations.

The meeting of the Governing Body shall be held every quarterly

Note :- If any G.B. Member should be absent from 3 (three) consecutive Meeting of the Governing Meeting of which due notice was given without valid reasons he shall de facto cease to be a member and the G.B. shall fill in the vacancy as it may deem proper.

12. **Power and Directors of the Governing Body** :

- (i) The G.B, shall have all powers necessary for the management and conduct of the S.C.A. and for promotion of its objects including the power to the action as may be deemed proper against affiliated members and players for the maintenance of discipline.
- (ii) To pass accounts up-to-date as presented by the Hony-Treasurer after duly being audited by the appointed audited of the S.C.A.
- (iii) Shall have all powers of inter-partition with regard to Rules and Regulations of the S.C.A. in case of any dispute.
- (iv) It shall have the power to frame Rules and bye-laws for the smooth conduct of the business of the Association from time to time. It may delegate certain powers to various committees and Sub-Committees whenever necessary.
- (v) To decide all disputes and matters referred to it by any affiliation Clubs, or the decisions of any offer because or other committee.
- (vi) It shall have the power to do any acts in the interest and development of Cricket and in furtherance of the objects of the S.C.A.
- (vii) To discuss and pass the Annual Budget of the S.C.A.



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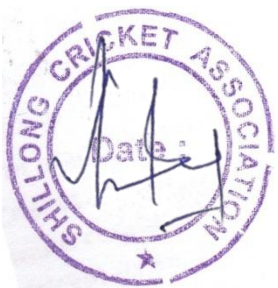
- (viii) To discuss and pass the Secretaries Report before presenting to the General Meeting.
- (ix) To accept any resignation of office Bearer/Member or members of any Sub-Committee of the S.C.A. and to fill-up any Vacancy caused due to any reasons till the Annual General Meeting.
- (x) To fix the date, time and agenda for Annual General Meeting and S.G.M.
- (xi) It shall form Sub-Committee when ever necessary and may delegate certain powers to the said Sub-committee and determine and regulate their contribution and working and may revoke such appointment.
- (xii) It shall supervise and examine the work of the Sub-Committee and office bearers.
- (xiii) It shall decide on the appeals against the decisions of the office bearers, sub-committee, etc., if any.
- (xiv) It may, by a two third majority of votes, take over the administration of any sub-committee, if such committees is found to be working very unsatisfactorily or on an appeal made by two thirds of the affiliated members of that particular sub-committees.
- (xv) The G.B. shall cause consent and complete accounts to be kept of all the scripts, accounts, payment, assets and liabilities of the Association and of all other matters necessary for showing the true state and financial condition of the Association.
- (xvi) It shall form the following sub-committees in the first-meeting of the newly constituent G.B.

(A) **Selection Sub-Committee** :-

This committee shall select the players to represent S.C.A. both Senior and Junior in all the Tournaments, that is going to participate. This committee shall consist of not-more than five (5) members to be elected from amongst the members of SCA. This committee shall have its own Chairman and it will be the responsibility of the Chairman to brief and explain to the Association on matter of selection. It is also mandatory on the part of the said committee members to be present themselves at the place where the selection that of the team is held. The list of players selected shall be sent to the President for final approval.

(B) **Tournament Sub-Committee** :-

This committee shall consist of not more than Eleven members including any Joint Secretary as Convener and one of the Vice-President as Chairman. This committee is responsible to organize matches in all



Tournament Organize by the S.C.A. and can arbitrate in case of protest in any Tournament of the S.C.A.

7 (seven) members shall form the quorum.

(C) **Umpire Board** :-

This committee shall consist of not must than 5 (five) members including one Secretary and one Chairman. To be an member of the sub-committee, person should be a member of the General Body. This committee deals with matters relating to the appointment of Umpire in any game conducted by the S.C.A. to organize Seminar and Examination and Umpire Clinic for the promotion of the of Umpiring in the District.

13. **Governing Body meeting and decisions** :

- (i) All meeting of the G.B. shall be summered by the General Secretary in consultation with the President Notice of such meeting shall note the agenda of business and ordinarily at least 5 (five) days previous notice shall be given. But in an urgent circumstances a meeting of the G.B. may be convened immediately.
- (ii) The General Secretary, may, in cases where the procedure is permitted, for quick disposal of urgent business, circulate paper to the members of the G.B. and the decisions of the majority shall prevail. Opinions thus obtained by circulation of papers shall have the activity of a meeting of the G.B.
- (iii) On-third of the members will form the quorum in G.B. Meeting. A meeting adjourned for want of quorum shall not require the requisite quorum. No member of the G.B. shall vote in connection with a matter in which a Guest, of which he is a member or representative, is concerned although he may take part in the discussion.
- (iv) If any members should be absent from this consecutions of the G.B. of which due notice was given without intimation in writing, he shall if so facto cease to be a member and the G.B. shall fill in the vacancy as it may deem proper.
- (v) The G.B. shall meet as often as may required for the disposal of the business of the Association.
- (vi) The decision of the G.B. shall be final and binding on all affiliation members and on any of its office bearers, members player except as provided elsewhere in the Contribution. No affiliated member, office bearer or player shall have recourse to law-courts in define of the decision of the G.B. It shall also not be in order for any higher authority like a State or All India Association (B.C.C.I.).
- (vii) The name of any affiliated member, office bearer or player thereof going to the law-courts or taking recourse to any other means against the decisions of the G.B. shall if-so-facto be summered from the S.C.A. and such members, office



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bearers or players shall not be allowed to take part any further in the games and activities of the Association.

- (viii) A decision taken in a meeting of the G.B. shall not ordinarily be attend. It can only be done if two thirds majority of the members of the G.B. approve the same in subsequent meeting.

14. **The Annual General Meeting :**

The Annual General Meeting shall be held ordinarily not taken than 30<sup>th</sup> August; each year. The notice of the meeting with agenda, date, time and venue shall be circulated at least 15 days ahead of the scheduled date of the meeting. Notice through pass should be given. However if the A.G.M. cannot be conveyed as noted above, due to any engineers, the matter may be placed in the G.B. for approval.

(A) **Quorum** :

- (i) One third of the total numbers of members of the S.C.A. shall from the requisite in such meeting.

(B) **Business to be transacted in the A.G.M.** :

- (i) To confirm the members of the previous A.G.M.  
(ii) To adopt the Annual Report of the Hony Secretary.  
(iii) To pass the Audited Statement of Account as presented by the Treasurer and as passed by the G.B.  
(iv) To pass the Annual Budget of the Association as passed by the G.B.  
(v) To consider any other matter with the permission from the Chair.  
(vi) To consider any proposal by any member of which 21 days notice has been given to the Hony. Secretary by the Concerned members.

15. **Voting** :

- (i) Every question at every meeting of the S.C.A. shall be decided by a simple majority of votes, either by secrete ballot or by voice as may be decided by the President of the meeting.  
(ii) In case of equality of votes on any question at any meeting of the S.C.A. the President shall have a casting vote.  
(iii) In case of a President himself is a candidate for any office which voting is taken place, he shall vacate the chair and the meeting will elect another senior members to transact the business.



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16. **Disciplinary Action** :

- (i) The G.B. of the S.C.A. shall have the power to suspend or expel any affiliated units of its convinced that such a unit or person has acted in a way detrimental to the interest of the S.C.A. and on recommendation of the Tournament Committee of the S.C.A. However such Clubs or person may appeal against the decision to the next higher authority such appeal must be rest to the President within 15 days from the date of the decision for consideration.
- (ii) In the event of any affiliated clubs being expelled or suspended under Clause 15 (i) or in subsequence of such expulsion or suspension, such clubs will not be allowed to take part in any Tournament organized by the S.C.A. till the suspension period is over.
- (iii) Any individual member of the club affiliated to the S.C.A. is suspended or expelled shall not be eligible to play in any Tournament conducted by S.C.A. or represent the S.C.A. in any Tournament that is going to take part.
- (iv) Any affiliated Clubs failing to fulfill the obligations mentioned in Article 4 shall were under the Clause of disciplinary action against any player or member or Affiliated Club either directly or indirectly if it feels that the person or Club concerned has acted in a manner which is detrimental to the interest of the S.C.A.

17. **Matches** :

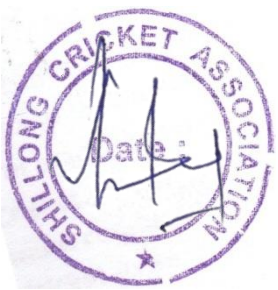
The Governing Body shall alone have the power to arrange matches total played by teams representing the S.C.A. whether within its jurisdiction or within the state or outside the State.

18. **Laws** :

Laws of Cricket laid down by the M.C.C. shall be followed by the S.C.A. except otherwise provided in rules or by laws specially prepared for any such purposes by the B.C.C.I. or the S.C.A.

19. **Eligibility of Players** :

- (i) In case of players taking part in matches representing the S.C.A. the rules frame by the A.C.A. or B.C.C.I. shall be applicable.
- (ii) In case of players playing or desirous of playing for any affiliated clubs/companies /Universities, they shall be considered as registered with the Association for which they have played until he or they, as the case may be has/have taken Inter District to another D.A./Companies/Universities. For taking such transfer a player must apply direct to the S.C.A. in case of an inter-club transfer and through his



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parent Association in case of Inter-District-Transfer fee of Rs. 75.00 (Rupees seventy five) only for player within the stipulate time notified by the Association from time to time.

- (iii) In case of any players selected to play for the S.C.A. in any Tournament he shall be informed through his Clubs. On receipt of such information, the Club concerned shall take necessary steps for making the player available either for the selection trial or for such selection or for representing the S.C.A. as the case may be. A player failing to report for such selection trial or the play for the S.C.A. on his being selected without adequate or genuine reason which must be to the satisfaction of the respective selection committee of the S.C.A., shall face disciplinary action. Affiliated Club failing to take necessary steps for making such players available to the S.C.A. for the above-mentioned purpose shall also fall the same disciplinary action.

20. **Office Bearers : Their Terms and Duties :**

The terms of office of the office bearers, members of the Governing Body a well as the Umpires Board will be of 2 (two) years. He may be elected as many term as long as the members present in the meeting think fill and proper to elect such members.

21. **Power and Duties of Office Bearers :**

(i) **President -**

- (a) The President shall preside over all the meeting of the Association i.e. the Governing Body an Annual and special General Meeting.
- (b) He shall cast one vote in the first instance and shall be entitled to a casting vote in any election held in the meeting in case of a tie between two or more candidates.
- (c) In the absence of the President one of the Vice-President will preside over the meeting and in the absence of all of them the members present shall elect one of themselves to be the Chairman of the meeting.
- (d) The President shall exercise General Supervision on the affairs of the Association and in the discharge of duties by the office bearers of the S.C.A.
- (e) In an emergence such as resignation by the Hony. General Secretary or in the case of a deadlock due to any cause the President shall take such steps as necessary or call a meeting of the General Body or the Governing Body of the S.C.A. to overcome such situation.



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(ii) **Vice-President** –

- (a) The Vice-Presidents shall assist the President in the discharge of his functions.
- (b) One of the Vice-Presidents shall exercise the powers of the President in the absence.
- (c) Each sub-committees of the S.C.A. formed by the G.B. will be headed by the Vice-Presidents.
- (d) Vice-President or Chairman presiding at meeting shall have a vote, and a casting vote in case of equality of votes.

22. **Powers and Duties of the Hony. General Secretary** :

The Hony. General Secretary is the Chief Executive Officer of the Association and his main duty shall be to see that the decisions, directions and orders of the G.B. are carried out by all the constitutions of the Association.

- (a) The Hony. General Secretary shall be elected in the Annual General Meeting of the S.C.A. when it is due. He shall be elected for the term of two years or till another Hony. General Secretary is elected and take charges. He will be eligible for re-election.
- (b) He shall have charge of all correspondence of the Association and sign and issue all tickets, badges and admission card. He shall operate the Bank Account of the S.C.A. jointly with the Hony. Treasurer or President.
- (c) He shall be in-charge of the properties of the S.C.A. including files, minutes and other materials. He should see and make sure that the minutes of all meetings of the G.B. and Association to be carefully recorded, confirm all keep in a book.
- (d) He shall prepare and submit the Annual Report before the Governing Body prior to the presentation of the same to the Annual General Meeting.
- (e) He shall keep an up-to-date Register of all affiliated Clubs/Units and Associations and ..... such register from time to time as occasion arise.
- (f) He shall have a custody of and maintain in proper order and condition all trophies, souvenirs and seal and insignia of the Association and of all property of the S.C.A.
- (g) He shall collect all subscriptions, and fees and get in with diligence all other moneys due and payable to the Association.
- (h) He shall make over as soon as possible all collection received or realized to the Treasurer and requisition him for such moneys as may from time to time be needed for the expenses of the Association after the impress cash in his hand is exhausted or for replenishing such cash.



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- (i) He shall always have an impress money of Rs. 1000/- (One thousand) only in his hand.
- (j) He shall be ex-officio member of all meeting within the Association and convene and attend all such meetings.
- (k) He shall convene all meeting and prepare the agenda of the meetings in consultation with the President and circulate minutes of all meeting to all the affiliated Club/Units.

23. **Hony. Joint Secretary :**

The Hony. Joint Secretaries will be in0charged of the selection and preparation of the District Team in consultation with the Hony. General Secretary and shall be responsible for conducting all business concerning the above Team. They may be the convener of the Senior Selection and Junior Selection Committee as appointed by the G.B. But they shall forward copies of all correspondence decisions to the Hony. General Secretary for information and necessary action. They are not entitled to make direct correspondence with any authorities outside the Associations and shall generally transact business in due consultation with the Hony. General Secretary.

24. **Hony. Treasurer :**

- (a) The Treasurer shall have charge of all Funds of the Association.
- (b) He shall deposit all money, as and when received from the Hony. General Secretary or any other sources into the account of the Association with any Banks in Shillong recognised by the Reserve Bank of India.
- (c) He shall advance money from time to time on a requisition by the Hony. General Secretary or President.
- (d) He shall cause the accounts of the S.C.A. to be property kept and audited by the Auditor or Chartered Accountant present the duty-audited statements of account at every annual meeting of the Association. He may be called upon the place before the G.B. detailed statement of income and expenditures of the S.C.A.

25. **Responsibility of Office Bearers and members of the Governing Body :**

All Office-Bearers and Members are responsible for the safe custody of all papers, documents, secrets and properties under this charge while holding office. They are responsible for handling their charges to their best when elected. Failure to comply with this provision will entail action including legal action by the Governing Body.

26. **Misconduct :**

In the event of any affiliated Club, Officers or member there-of being proved to the satisfaction of the G.B. to have been guilty of any breach of the Laws of the games or



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Rules, Regulations or Bye Laws of the S.C.A. or of any misconduct, the G.B. may order the offending Club, Officer, player or member to be suspended for such period as it may think fit or otherwise to be death with as the G.B. may think fit and proper.

27. **Colour and Badges** :

- (a) The colour of the Flag of the S.C.A. shall be as per approved design
- (b) The colour of the badge of S.C.A. shall be as per approved design.

28. **Protests** :

- (a) Every protest lodged by an official of an affiliated Club shall be in writing and in triplicate duly signed by them and professed to the Hony. General Secretary within 24 (twenty four) hours (Sunday & Holiday excluded) of occurrence to which it relates accompanied with a fee of Rs. 200.00 (Rupees Two hundred) which shall be forfeited to the fund of the S.C.A. in the event of the protest being rejected.
- (b) Ev ery appeal lodged by an affiliated unit shall be preferred in writing in triplicate to the Hony. General Sunday within 24 hrs. (Sunday and Holiday excluded) from the date of script of the division of the Association, accompanied with a fee of Rs. 500.00. The lodging of such appeal shall not operate as stay of any decision to which that selects pending the decision by the council under the council so directs.

29. **Legal Action** :

The Association may sue or be sued in the name of the President and or General Secretary of the Association.

30. **Borrowing by the Association** :

For the purpose of developing the game of Cricket, the Governing Body have the power to borrow money from banks, private individuals or from any other source(s) and may create mortgage by way of hypothecation, pledge, assignment, lien on the moveable and or immovable properties of the Association, as the case may be, the secure the due replacement of the borrowings.

The power under this section, shall be vested by the Governing Body by a selection for this purpose.



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31. **Amendment of the Rules :**

- (a) Notice of any proposed amendment of the Rules of the S.C.A. shall be submitted in writing to Hony. General Secretary, together with the name of the proposer and recorder who shall be members of the Association. The proposal will then be submitted for disposal at the Annual General Meeting or Special General Meeting of the Association. No amendment or alteration will be effective in the Rules of the Association unless two thirds of the members present at such meeting vote in favour of such amendment or alteration.
- (b) Any club or Association affiliated to the S.C.A. may give notice to be submitted at the Annual General Meeting of the S.C.A. Such notice shall be given in writing to the Hony. General Secretary on or before the thirtieth day of June in each year and a copy of such notice, with the name of the proposer and recorder who shall be members of the S.C.A., shall be sent by the Hony. General Secretary to all affiliated Club not later than seven clear days' before the date fixed for the Annual General meeting at which it is to be submitted.
- (c) Any amendment of the constitution duly passed by the General Body shall come into force with immediate effect.

32. **Bank Account :**

All money of the S.C.A. shall be kept in the Bank which is recognized by the R.B.I. at Shillong. The Account shall be operate jointly by any two of the following office bearers of which the Hony. Treasurer shall be common.

- (a) President
- (b) Hony. General Secretary
- (c) Hony. Treasurer
- (d) Any other member of the existing executive body approved by the Governing Body

33. **Winding – Up or Dissolution :**

If upon the dissolution of the Association there shall remain after satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities any property whatsoever, the same shall not be paid to or distributed amongst the members of the Association, but shall be handed over to some other societies to be determined by the votes of not less than three-fourth of the members present at the time of dissolution.



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
